The current Victorian graveyard, lying in the curtilage of the deconsecrated St Pancras Church, sits adjacent to the Cemetery.

The Memorial Garden Cemetery was created to fill a continuing

need and despite being a small cemetery, it is available to all.

Each interment (ashes or burial) is in perpetuity.

The Rousdon Estate

The Memorial Garden Cemetery lies within The Rousdon Estate 500 feet up on the Devon/Dorset border. The 350-acre Estate is a private gated village; home to an eclectic mix of permanent residents and long-term tenants.

There are 104 homes on the 350-acre site, and the community is managed by the residents themselves, through the private company Allhallows Limited.

The Estate is not a traditional village with a single, famous owner, but rather a unique residential enclave. Its demographic is made up of a diverse mix of people from all walks of life.

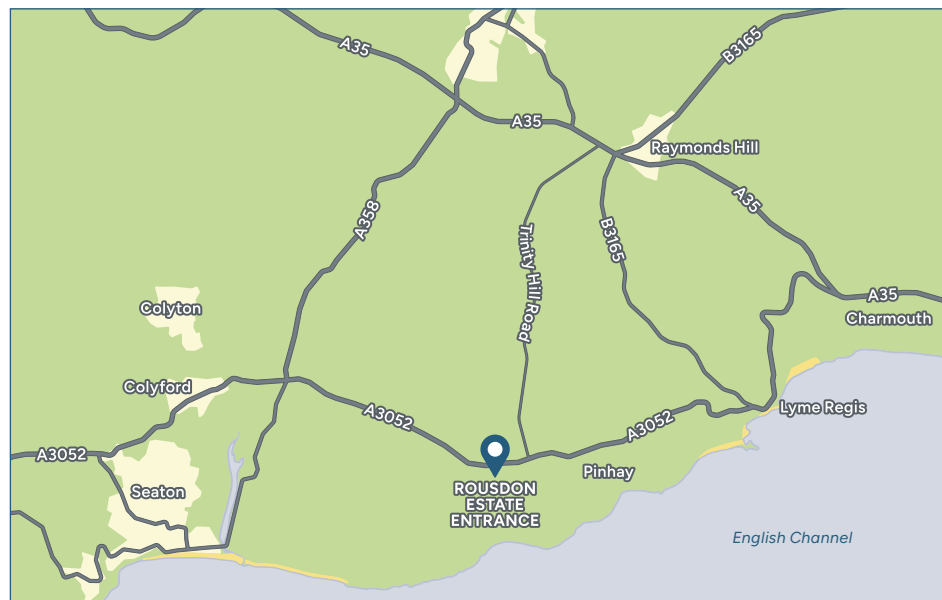
Because it is a private area, the only people on the property are the residents and guests staying in the various estate cottages. The only open access is the bridleway between West and East lodges.

How to find us

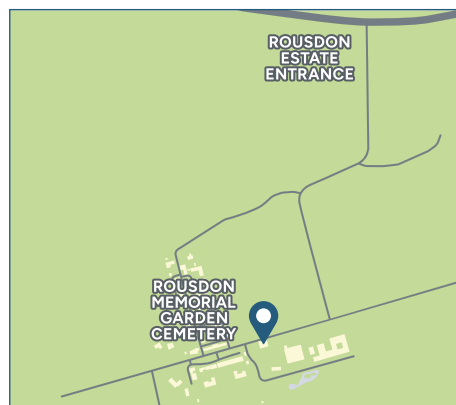
Directions

The Rousdon Estate is located on Boshill on the A3052. The Estate entrance is on your right as you enter the village of Rousdon from the West. From the A35 Charmouth Road, turn left (from the East) or right (from the West) onto Trinity Hill Road. After 3.5 miles turn right onto A3052. After just under half a mile, the entrance to the Rousdon Estate will be on your left.



Access

On entering the Estate, continue for half a mile until you reach a junction. Turn right and the entrance to the Cemetery will be on your left and adjacent to St Pancras church.





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
